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Clarification: Table 5.4 of the Monograph (that lists the 69 carcinogens) is missing a carcinogen, namely MeAaC (2-amino-3-methyl-9-H-pyrido[2,3-b]indole, which should be inserted under "under "Miscellaneous Organic Compounds".
